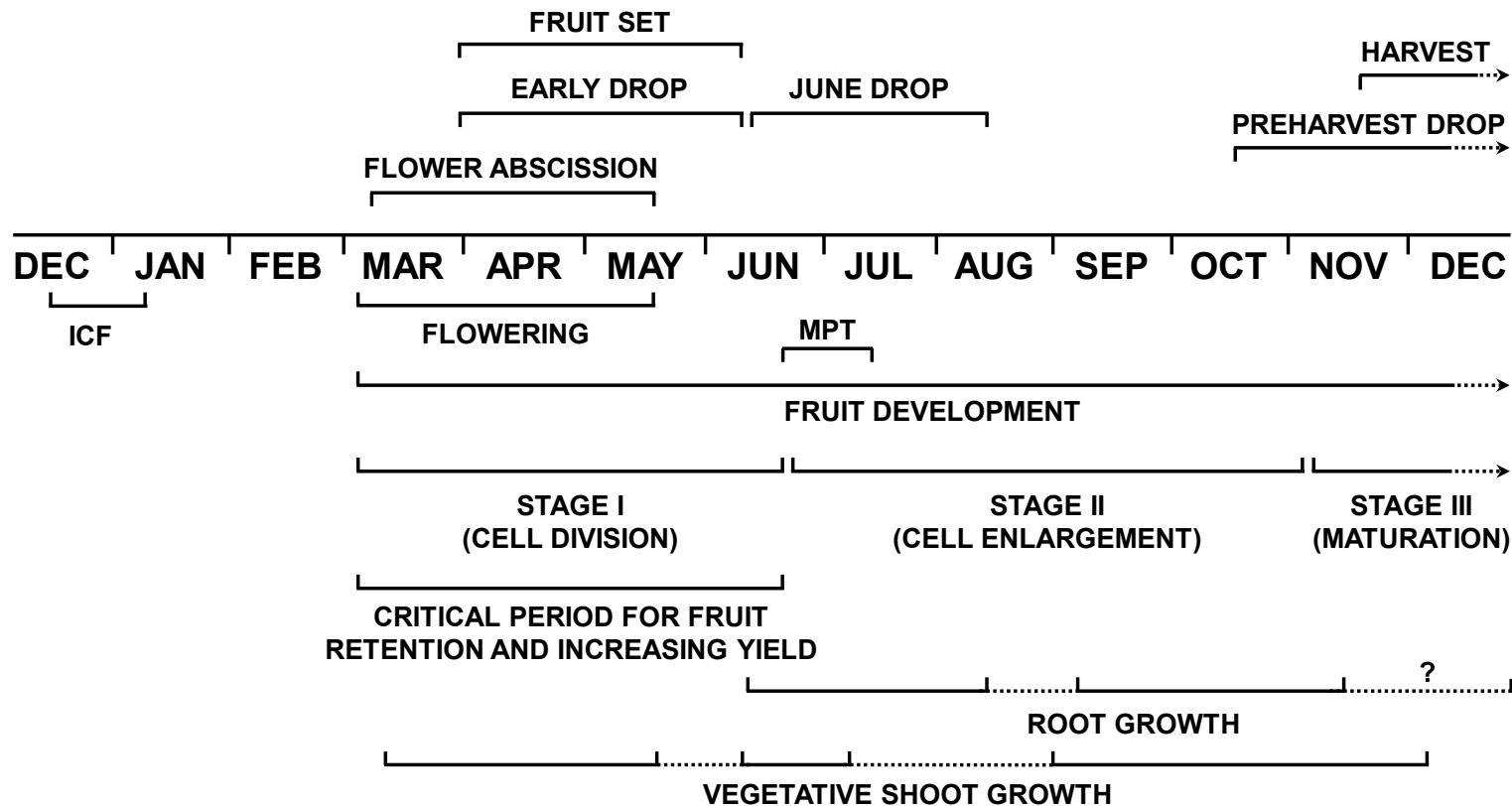


# Phenology of the 'Washington' navel orange in California



ICF = Irreversible commitment to flowering.

MPT = Maximum peel thickness.

Stage I (cell division) = slow increase in fruit size.

Stage II (cell enlargement) = rapid increase in fruit size.

Stage III (maturation) = slow increase in fruit size.
